We have already implemented **Seminar for standardization** at which we talked about human rights of Internet users, online safety and privacy in youth work. Stakeholders discussed challenges of youth work when it comes to protecting young people's online safety and privacy and ensuring protection of their rights while doing youth work activities. Their proposals became a part of the Guide for youth organizations that should help them to apply procedures ensuring data protection of young people according to GDPR and Rights of Internet Users recommendations. With you we would like to finalize this Guide and get the party started with implementing it in youth organizations. Basically, we want you to be the first group of peer advisors that will help youth organizations to become digitally safe for their users.
